

Memorandum of Understanding

Shree Chanakya Education Society's Indira Institute of Management (IIMP) received autonomy in the year 2019. IIMP introduced a degree level program Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) in the academic year 2019-20 and added a specialization in Healthcare Management under BBA program in the year 2020-21. Healthcare Management is very specifically targeted towards the aspirants who want to build their managerial career in healthcare and hospital management. This program consists of some technical subjects from Pharma and Medical field. The management of IIMP approached Indira College of Pharmacy (ICP) one of the constituent college of Shree Chanakya Education Society to extend the technical support to effectively deliver this program.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made on this 08-06-2021 between Indira Institute of Management, Pune (IIMP) and Indira College of Pharmacy (ICP)

The MOU shall remain in force from 01-06-2021 to 31-05-2026

1) Responsibilities of Indira Institute of Management:

1) Admissions:

IIMP will take the entire responsibility of admissions of the students to the program

2) Curriculum Design and Delivery :

IIMP will take the primary responsibility of designing the curriculum of courses for BBA (Healthcare Management) and will seek input from Indira College of Pharmacy for technical subjects focused on pharmaceutical and healthcare. IIMP will take complete responsibility of administration and delivery of the program.

3) Faculty :

IIMP will recruit few core faculty teach the courses to BBA (Healthcare Management) students.

4) Industry Connect:

IIMP will communicate and coordinate with the Industry people and will draft the MOUs with the Industry. The IIMP will also take the responsibility of liasoning with industry and administration of such MOUs.

5) Examination and evaluation:

IIMP will take the complete responsibility of examination, evaluation and results of the students studying in BBA (Healthcare management)

6) Sharing of Revenue:

Towards all the support and help extended by Indira College of Pharmacy as above; Indira Institute of Management will share 30 % of the revenue earned from BBA (Healthcare Management) program with Indira College of Pharmacy.

7) Administrative Support:

Indira Institute of Management will provide all administrative support and help for execution of this MOU with Indira College of Pharmacy.

II) Responsibilities of Indira College of Pharmacy:

Indira College of Pharmacy agrees to provide following support to Indira Institute of Management.

1) Curriculum Design :

Indira college of Pharmacy (ICP) will extend support in designing the curriculum of course for BBA (Healthcare Management) wherever healthcare/pharmacy specialized subjects are involved.

2) Faculty Deputation :

ICP will depute faculty to teach specialized subject related to healthcare/pharmacy to BBA (Healthcare Management) students.

3) Industry Connect:

ICP will help in arranging internships for students and help in signing MoUs with organizations in healthcare sector.

4) Academic Assistance:

ICP will assist in upgrading and updating the course structure and syllabus of BBA (Healthcare Management) from time to time.

5) Access to the Resources:

ICP will allow the BBA (Healthcare management) students of IIMP to its infrastructure if required like laboratory, books & other equipment which are required to teach the curriculum related to healthcare specialization. IIMP will take specific permission from the Principal of ICP for each such visit of IIMP students.
